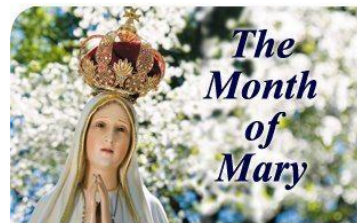

May 21<sup>st</sup> marks the one year anniversary of an EF2 tornado with wind speeds of 195 km/h that ripped through downtown Uxbridge, leaving a swatch of destruction more than 4 km long. Our parish rectory was in the path of this devastating tornado. Miraculously, our church and Our Lady's grotto was not damaged, but the rectory had an enormous tree rip through the roof. We survived months of no electricity, no heat or air conditioning, insurance agents, construction, repairs as well as Fr. Gerard having to stay in the neighbouring parish. It was a challenge but now it is a memory. The love of God shone through the care, concern and support of our parishioners. Almost all repairs are now complete, except for repairs to the garage. We remember and give thanks for we are truly blessed.
