Ordinary Time is the season in which we celebrate the life and teachings of Jesus Christ and what it means to be his



disciple. The name of this season is derived from the word *ordinal*, meaning "to count." We call Ordinary Time *ordinary* because the weeks are named in number order. Ordinary Time is divided into two parts. The first falls between Christmas and Lent. The second occurs between the seasons of Easter and Advent. Green, seen everywhere in plants and trees, symbolizes life and hope and is the color used during Ordinary Time. The second part of ordinary time began on May 29<sup>th</sup>.
