EVANGELIZATION OF THE NATIONS – COLLECTION ON OCTOBER 22nd, 2023

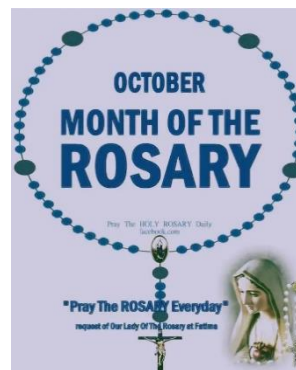
