

The Church celebrates the feast of St. Blaise, on Feb. 3rd. St. Blaise, was bishop of Sebaste in Armenia in the fourth



century. Before being martyred, he is said to have healed a boy who was choking. Since the eighth century, St. Blaise has been venerated as the patron of those who suffer from diseases of the throat. We pray in a special way on this day for protection from afflictions of the throat and from other illnesses. The blessing of St. Blaise is a sign of our faith in God's protection and love for us and for the sick.
