**2023 TAX RECEIPTS**

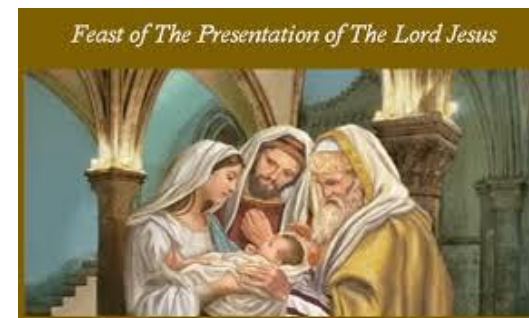

The Church celebrates the feast of St. Blaise, on Feb. 3<sup>rd</sup>. St. Blaise, was bishop of Sebaste in Armenia in the fourth century. Before being martyred, he is said to have healed a boy who was choking. Since the eighth century, St. Blaise has been venerated as the patron of those who suffer from diseases of the throat. We pray in a special way on this day for protection from afflictions of the throat and from other illnesses. The blessing of St. Blaise is a sign of our faith in God's protection and love for us and for the sick.
