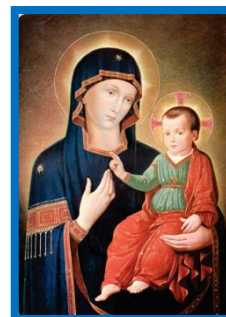


**Risen Lord,
