


REQUESTING A MASS INTENTION?

The practice of requesting a Mass to be offered for loved ones, living or deceased, is a beautiful part of our Catholic tradition. A Mass request (announced \$20 or unannounced \$10) may be made for a deceased person, a living person who is sick, a living person celebrating a birthday or anniversary, in thanksgiving, or an intention fitting to the Eucharistic celebration. (vocations, world peace, etc.). The person requesting a Mass intention may ask for a card that they can send to notify the person that the Mass intention has been offered. Please call 905-852-6944 or email the parish office if you wish to request a Mass intention.
