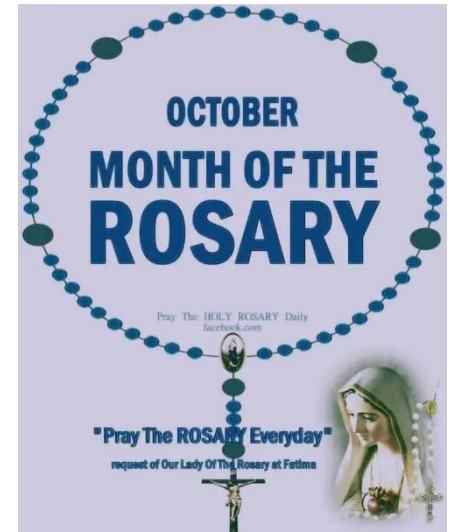


OCTOBER 5/6, 2024 SPECIAL COLLECTION - INDIGENOUS HEALING & RECONCILIATION
