FASTING & ABISTENCE

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of
obligatory fasting and abstinence for all Catholics
from age 14 until age 59. Fasting means a person is
permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may
also be taken, but they are not to equal that of a full
meal. In addition, Catholics must abstain from meat on
all Fridays during Lent.
