FRANK CARDINAL LEO APPOINTED AS MEMBER TO VATICAN'S DICASTERY FOR INTERRELIGIOUS DIALOGUE

On July 3, 2025, the Vatican announced the appointment of Frank Cardinal Leo, Metropolitan Archbishop of Toronto as a member to the Dicastery for Interreligious Dialogue. A dicastery is a department of the Roman Curia, the administrative body of the Holy See. The appointment does not impact Cardinal Leo's ministry as Metropolitan Archbishop of Toronto. We pray for Cardinal Leo as he takes on this new appointment and for all those who continue to foster goodwill and cooperation among people of all faiths.
