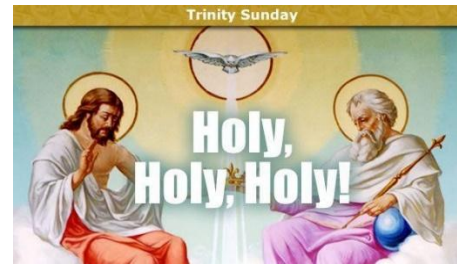

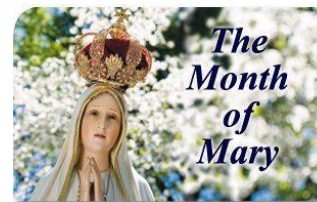
**A NOTE ON
